7 Absolutes to Living Well and Finishing Strong

The challenge is to keep growing in each of these areas and not be too weighted in any one or two areas and overlook the others. BW

- 2. Bring order to our Money and Finances
- 3. Clarify why you go to Work and what your Purpose is
- 4. Define true Success and Significance
- 5. Value Relationships and Community
- 6. Respond appropriately to life's Circumstances and Challenges
- 7. Handle your Resources with Generosity

As we read and reflect on these seven areas over the next view weeks, consider are you in chaos, order, or maturity. The process will take time to move to maturity. If you are in chaos focus on moving to order you will not be able to be mature <u>until you have</u> order.

This is the goal of our equipping, Ephesians 4:13, "until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ." BW
