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Discipleship and Disciple-making (Part 23)

Last week we looked further into the new man (rebirth) that we read about in 2 Corinthians 5:17 and John 3:3.

Three important topics from 2 Corinthians 5:17-20 are:

1. In verse 17 the **new identity** of the person who belongs to Christ.
2. In verses 18 and 19 it is written about the **new relationship** that believers have with God.
3. In verses 20 and 21 we read again about the **new calling** we now have.

This week we're going to look at the **new relationship** we're in (verses 18 and 19).

The new identity is about WHO I am now. That means I'm different now.

The new relationship tells us WHOSE I am now. That means I'm safe now.

Read verses 18 and 19 in different translations and write it in your own words:
