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Discipleship and Disciple-making (Part 30)

For the past 29 weeks, we have looked at what discipleship is, what disciple-making is and how to start the process. During this time, the Lord has also taken me on a journey on this subject, and I am also confronted every day about my willingness and involvement.

Before we go any further, it might be good that we just reassert a few thoughts:

1. Matthew 28:19-20 is Jesus' plan and command.
2. If I consider myself a disciple or follower of Jesus, then this commission/calling/opportunity is for me as well.
3. Am I obeying Him or am I doing what is convenient for me? (Romans 8:5b)
4. Am I being led by the Holy Spirit every day? (Romans 8:9)
5. Am I making myself available as an instrument in God's hand?
6. Do I understand that it is not about me, but about the people He sends my way? (Philippians 2:1-5)
7. How serious am I about people who are in my sphere of influence accepting Jesus Christ as Saviour? (John 17:17)
8. Do I pray for them regularly?
9. Do I understand my new identity in Christ? (2 Cor. 5:17-20)
10. Do I feel the need to grow even more in Him and help others grow too? (Hebrews 5:12)

These are just a few questions that come to mind and that I have to answer myself.

There are still many questions we can ask to hold each other accountable.
